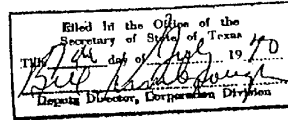

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF



SAN ANTONIO FIRE AND POLICE PENSIONERS' ASSOCIATION

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more, at least two of whom are citizens of the State of Texas, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is San Antonio Fire and Police Pensioners' Association.

ARTICLE TWO

The corporation is a non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE THREE

The period of its duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE FOUR

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are: To unite the pensioners of the Firemen and Policemen's Pension Fund of San Antonio, Texas, for the benefit of their common welfare.

ARTICLE FIVE

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 124 West Mariposa Drive, San Antonio, Texas 78212, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is A. G. Campa.

ARTICLE SIX

The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors of the corporation is nine and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as the initial directors (all residing in San Antonio, Texas,) are:
